Mission Maestro Version 4.0 Scheduled for June Release

Mission Maestro Version 4.0 has been in Beta Testing at client sites over the last few weeks. Several beta sites have requested more time to test the new functionality and provide additional feedback. Version 4.0 is now scheduled to be released in the first week of June.

In addition to the Correspondence enhancements, here are some of the improvements we've made:

1. Documentation for Version 4.0 will include screen shots showing the source of correspondence query fields.
2. Starting with Version 4.0:
 - Each update will install the latest version of mmbackup.exe, the Mission Maestro Backup Utility that automatically generates a backup of your Mission Maestro system, into your Mission Maestro directory.
 - Each update will install the latest version of the Report Writer Data Dictionary and the Report Writer User's Manual into a supporting documents directory.

First Chair Version 4.0 Update Available for Purchase in June

Since First Chair is a modular version of Mission Maestro, all enhancements to Mission Maestro will also be available in the First Chair update. For example, all Correspondence enhancements will be available as part of the basic First Chair update.

The update will be available for purchase in the Online Store inside the Clubhouse at www.firstchair.com. You must be a registered user to enter the clubhouse.

If you purchased First Chair, but haven't registered yet, click on 'Register CD' on the First Chair homepage. After you register and select a password, you will have the option to enter the clubhouse. Once you are in the clubhouse, click the 'Updates' link in the Online Store graphic on the right hand side of the page.

Quick Tip - Sending HTML Email to People with the Same Role

HTML Email is now available when using our Email Editor to send One-Off Emails. You may send emails to people based on one of their roles, 'Newsletter Recipient' for example.

1. Go to File - Send Email.
2. Click on the addressing option you want to use, either To, CC, or BCC.
3. A Person Query will display.
4. Go to the Role field, and use the Pull-Down menu to select the role of the people to which you want to send the email. 'Newsletter recipient' for example.
5. Click 'Select All'.
6. Click 'OK'.
7. All people with the role of 'Newsletter Recipient' have been added to your email. Complete your email and send.

Note: as with any mass-mailing, some e-mail clients or hosts may limit the number of recipients, and may mark any larger-volume email as "spam."
